

<u>UPCOMING AND ONGOING</u>

Called by Quaker values and our love of the community around us, the Meeting has services and activities continuing that serve the neighborhood and strengthen our connection with families and individuals in Old Trenton Neighborhood.

<u>Arm In Arm</u> will be continuing to provide the bags of groceries, produce and meat on Tuesday mornings.

<u>Piano lessons</u> for young people in the neighborhood are on Saturdays. Neighbors can let us know if their child would like beginning piano lessons..

<u>Black Lives Matter NJ</u> has their monthly outreach providing "to go" spaghetti dinners, care packs, and other items like clothes, gloves and socks. This happens on fourth Saturdays but skipping November.

<u>Monthly Free Sale</u> on the sidewalk in front of the Meetinghouse will be on the fourth Saturdays, matching the BLM outreach dates for the rest of the year.

<u>Prayers For Peace</u>, a 45 minute vigil, is monthly on the second Saturday starting at 10:15 am.

<u>TRENTON'S QUAKER PRIORITIES</u>

In order to have a meaningful Quaker presence in Trenton, our Meeting has emphasized connection with and service to the folks that live near us and the friends that pass by our historic Meeting House every day. We strive to support families with large efforts like the Arm In Arm food bags and Black Lives Matter NJ outreach, and small such as free beginning piano lessons and regular children's activities. We use our resources to support local organizations and businesses that complement our values and add to the neighborhood and the city.

Another very necessary priority is maintaining the Meeting House. 285 years old this year, we continue to face challenges and choices such as water invading the ceiling or old plumbing failures. There is a responsibility to the future that we maintain now and not "pass the buck".

<u>WHY ARE WE A "PEACE CHURCH"?</u>

The Religious Society of Friends (Ouaker) is one of a handful of religious groups that has been recognized over the course of our history as a "Peace Church". Mennonites. Amish and Church of the Brethren are others. What does Peace Church mean? It means that as a central tenet. testimony or belief, these faith organizations hold that violence is to be rejected between people, communities and nations. Non-violent resistance and proactive work to head off wars and violence is our way of rectifying injustice and conflict. September 21st is noted every year as "International Day of Peace". It is a reminder of the choices we must make and the work we must do to foster a more peaceful society and a more peaceful world.
